We wish to welcome a new car club to our ranks. The **Rumblers Car Club** joined the Council at this meeting.

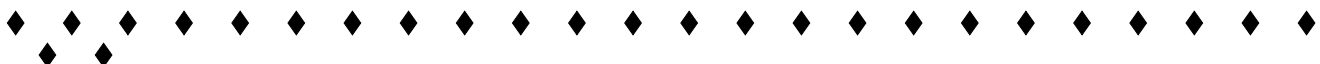
At this point the meeting was adjourned at 8:20 PM.
