At the end of the day our tally showed that we had between 360-380 entries in the show.

By-Laws Changes- **Lisa BonDurant** spoke about the By-Laws Committee meeting and that the changes proposed will be posted on line for the clubs to vote on. Each club will be allowed one vote.

New Business:

Collector Car Appreciation Day- **John Doran** spoke about the "Collector Car Appreciation Day" which will be held on July 13, 2012. In New Mexico the festivities will begin in Santa Fe at the Statehouse where the proclamation will be read.
